Direct your planning:

Voice your opinion at hearings and meetings and start planning your own goals in life!

Prevent long term foster care:

The use of Another **Planned Permanent Living** Arrangement (APPLA) can no longer be your goal. Work to build family supports and permanent connections!

Older youth services:

Independent Living Services are now available from age 14 until 21!

Rights:

You must be given your rights and steps to file a grievance with issues, problems, or disagreements with your case plan.

Normalcy Rights and Opportunities for Youth in **Foster Care!**

Case planning:

Starting at age 14, you can make your own choice of 2 people to help with your case plan and transition plan. One can be your advocate for normalcy.

Credit

Credit reports will be done annually and your caseworker must help you with incorrect information.

reports:

Normalcy:

The opportunity to participate in school or social activities must be discussed with your team and the judge.

Parenting decisions:

Your resource parent can now make decisions and give permission for school and social activities.

Documents:

You must be given a copy of all your identification documents and medical records when leaving care.
