Eligibility for OCMI Services:

- ♦ Youth who are 10 years of age or older
- Youth with the primary goal of adoption and legally free-unless the dependency court will not terminated parental rights until an adoptive resource has been identified.
- Youth must be eligible for Pennsylvania Adoption Exchange (PAE) registration
- ♦ Sibling groups that meet eligibility requirements; only 1 youth must be 10
