

The Pennsylvania Child Welfare Resource Center (Resource Center) has a full-time open position for a Youth Ambassador. The Youth Ambassador brings a youth and foster care perspective to the various state initiatives of the Pennsylvania Child Welfare Resource Center. The Youth Ambassador will gain a representative view of Pennsylvania's older foster youth through extensive interaction with youth throughout the State who are or have been in substitute care. Based on these interactions, this individual will provide feedback to the Resource Center staff and other statewide stakeholders in efforts to enhance child welfare practices for better outcomes for children, youth, and families throughout Pennsylvania. The Youth Ambassador must effectively articulate experiences as a youth in out-of-home care and be willing to share those experiences and make connections to other youth's experiences in a group context. The Youth Ambassador functions as a member of the Statewide Quality Improvement Department. The incumbent must have been in substitute care past age 14 and eligible for Independent Living services within the past three years.
